A RESOLUTION to call a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing a State of the State address by Governor Phil Bredesen.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 3-1-108, provides for a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives to be called annually for the purpose of hearing a State of the State address by the governor; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that the Senate and the House of Representatives meet in joint convention on Monday, February 5, 2007, at 5:30 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing the State of the State address by the Honorable Phil Bredesen, Governor of Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Governor Bredesen be invited to address the joint convention on Monday, February 5, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives.
