AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to teacher evaluations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The office of education accountability within the office of the comptroller of the treasury, in consultation with the department of education, shall survey other states to determine how states use measures of parental involvement and student accountability in evaluating teacher performance. The office of education accountability shall report its findings to the general assembly by January 15, 2011. The office of education accountability shall make an oral presentation of its report to the education committee of the house of representatives and the education committee of the senate at times to be determined by the chairs of the respective committees.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
