**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 510**

A RESOLUTION to designate a bridge on State Route 273 in Lincoln County as the "Floyd Hall and Sons Memorial Bridge".

WHEREAS, from time to time, the members of this General Assembly have seen fit to name certain highways and bridges to honor those citizens who have proudly and courageously served their country in the United States Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, no Tennessean could be more deserving of this honor than the late Floyd Hall and his sons who collectively served 103 years in this nation's military; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners has petitioned this body to name a certain bridge on State Route 273 to permanently commemorate the Hall family's patriotism, courage, and commitment to duty; and

WHEREAS, this General Assembly concurs with this excellent proposal; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the newly constructed bridge on State Route 273 that spans Bradshaw Creek in the Dellrose community in Lincoln County is hereby designated the "Floyd Hall and Sons Memorial Bridge" to honor 103 years of collective military service by Mr. Hall and his sons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating the bridge described in the first resolving clause as the "Floyd Hall and Sons Memorial Bridge".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the erection of such signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the Commissioner of Transportation in writing that the provisions of this resolution shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall become operative only if the cost of the manufacture and installation of such signs is paid to the Department of Transportation by Lincoln County within one (1) year of the effective date of this resolution. Such payment shall be made prior to any expenditure by the state for the

manufacture or installation of such signs. The department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to Lincoln County within thirty (30) days of the erection of such signs. If the actual cost exceeds the estimated cost, an amount equal to the difference in such costs shall be remitted to the department by Lincoln County within thirty (30) days of the county receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an enrolled copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Commissioner of Transportation.
