SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 633

A RESOLUTION to call a joint convention of the Senate and the House of Representatives for the purpose of electing members of the State Election Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-104, provides that members of the State Election Commission be elected by joint resolution of both houses of the General Assembly, such election to take place in joint session of both houses; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-105, provides that vacancies in the membership of the State Election Commission may be filled by the General Assembly in the same manner as full terms are filled; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 547/House Bill No. 845 (Public Chapter No. ___ of 2009) adds two (2) additional majority party members to the State Election Commission to serve only until the other commissioners' terms expire; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the Senate and the House of Representatives meet in joint convention in the chamber of the House of Representatives at 9:00 a.m. (CDT) on Wednesday, June 10, 2009, for the purpose of holding an election to fill the two (2) vacancies on the State Election Commission created by Senate Bill No. 547/House Bill No. 845 (Public Chapter No. ___ of 2009).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the Governor does not sign Senate Bill No. 547/House Bill No. 845 (Public Chapter No. ___ of 2009) prior to 9:00 a.m. (CDT) on June 10, 2009, then this resolution shall be void and have no effect.
