HOUSE BILL NO. 207

AN ACT to authorize the possession, storage, use, manufacture, or sale of pyrotechnics in Hawkins County, and to repeal Chapter 617 of the Private Acts of 1947; and any other acts amendatory thereto.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 617 of the Private Acts of 1947, and any acts amendatory thereto, is repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Hawkins County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the Hawkins County legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.


