AN ACT to amend Chapter 115 of the Private Acts of 1995, relative to occupancy tax in the City of Harriman.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Chapter 115 of the Private Acts of 1995, and all other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting from Section 2 the language "five percent (5%)" and by substituting instead the language "seven percent (7%)".

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the City of Harriman, not more than ninety (90) days subsequent to its approval by the Governor. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and shall be certified by him to the Secretary of State.

SECTION 3. For the purposes of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect upon being approved as provided in Section 2.
