AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6, Chapter 51, Part 1, relative to changing municipal boundaries and filing annexation boundaries.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 6, Chapter 51, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

6-51-121. Upon adoption of an annexation ordinance or upon referendum approval of an annexation resolution as provided in this part, an annexing municipality shall record the ordinance or resolution with the register of deeds in the county or counties where the annexation was adopted or approved. The ordinance or resolution shall describe the territory that was annexed by the municipality. A copy of the ordinance or resolution shall also be sent to the comptroller of the treasury and the assessor of property for each county affected by the annexation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
