AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 11, Part 1, relative to the state election commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-101(a), is amended by deleting the language "five (5)" and substituting instead the language "seven (7)".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-103, is amended by deleting subsection (a) and substituting instead the following:

(a) Four (4) members of the commission shall be members of the majority party, and three (3) members of the commission shall be members of the minority party.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-112, is amended by deleting the language "or any other regular November election occurring every four (4) years thereafter" and the language "temporarily" in the first sentence of the section.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-112, is further amended by deleting the last sentence of the section.

SECTION 5. It is the intent of the general assembly that this act not increase the amount appropriated for compensation and travel expenses due to the increase in members serving on the commission. Each member shall receive compensation and travel expenses in accordance with § 2-11-107 and § 2-11-108.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
