AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-305 and Section 29-20-307, relative to the jurisdiction for certain actions involving governmental entities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-305(a), is amended by deleting the language "counties having a population of more than six hundred thousand (600,000) according to the 1970 federal census or any subsequent federal census" and by substituting instead the language "counties having a population of more than eight hundred fifty thousand (850,000), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census."

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-307, is amended by deleting the language "counties having a population of more than six hundred thousand (600,000) according to the 1970 federal census or any subsequent federal census" and by substituting instead the language "counties having a population of more than eight hundred fifty thousand (850,000), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census."

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
