AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 39, Part 2, relative to sexual offender monitoring.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-39-204, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

(h) Each offender shall report to the designated law enforcement agency at least twenty-one (21) days before travelling out of the country; provided, that offenders who travel out of the country frequently for work or other legitimate purpose, with the written approval of the designated law enforcement agency, and offenders who travel out of the country for emergency situations shall report to the designated law enforcement agency at least twenty-four (24) hours before travelling out of the country.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
