AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 69, Chapter 6, Part 1, relative to watershed districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-6-142, is amended by deleting subsection (d) in its entirety and substituting instead the following language:

(d) Each district shall prepare and submit an annual report of its business affairs and transactions to the state soil conservation committee and the comptroller of the treasury.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-6-148(a), is amended by adding the following language:

The watershed district shall file a true and correct copy of the dissolution with the state soil conservation committee.


SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-6-148(b), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subsection:

In the event a watershed district is dissolved under the provisions of this subsection, the chair of the state soil conservation committee shall file a notice of dissolution with the secretary of state and upon such filing the watershed district shall no longer be deemed to exist. The chair of the state soil conservation committee shall file a true and correct copy of the notice of dissolution with the register of deeds of the county or counties in which the watershed district is located.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
