AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, to authorize the issuance of a special license plate for FedExFamilyHouse.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-202(c)(7), is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() FedExFamilyHouse;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, Part 2, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated section:

(a) Owners or lessees of motor vehicles who are residents of the state of Tennessee, upon complying with state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles and paying the regular fee applicable to the motor vehicle and the fee provided for in § 55-4-203, shall be issued a FedExFamilyHouse new specialty earmarked license plate for a motor vehicle authorized by § 55-4-210(c).

(b) The new specialty earmarked license plates provided for in this section shall contain an appropriate logo or design representative of the organization and shall be designed in consultation with Le Bonheur Children's Hospital Foundation.

(c) In accordance with § 55-4-215, the funds produced from the sale of FedExFamilyHouse new specialty earmarked license plates shall be allocated to Le Bonheur Children's Hospital Foundation to be used exclusively to support the FedExFamilyHouse, a home away from home for families of patients receiving extended care at Le Bonheur Children's Hospital.


SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, the public welfare requiring it.
