AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-431, relative to criminal offenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-431(m)(1)(A), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and substituting the following:

(A) Attempt to sell the product knowing that it will be used to produce methamphetamine, or with reckless disregard of its intended use;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-431(m)(1)(B), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and substituting the following:

(B) Attempt to purchase the product with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine or deliver the product to another person whom they know intends to manufacture methamphetamine, or with reckless disregard of the other person's intent;

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.


