AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, to authorize the issuance of new specialty earmarked license plates to promote brain injury awareness.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-202(c)(7), is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Brain injury awareness;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, Part 2, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated section:

55-4-2__.

(a) An owner or lessee of a motor vehicle who is a resident of this state, upon complying with state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles and paying the regular fee applicable to the motor vehicle and the fee provided in § 55-4-203, shall be issued a brain injury awareness new specialty earmarked license plate for a motor vehicle authorized by § 55-4-210(c).

(b) The new specialty earmarked license plates authorized by this section shall be designed in consultation with the Brain Injury Association of Tennessee.

(c) The funds produced from the sale of brain injury awareness new specialty earmarked license plates shall be allocated to the Brain Injury Association of Tennessee, in accordance with § 55-4-215. Such funds shall be used exclusively to fund the Brain Injury Association of Tennessee's camp for survivors.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, the public welfare requiring it.


