AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70, Chapter 2, relative to reduced fee or free licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-104, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection thereto:

(e)(1) This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Hunter Wright Hunting and Fishing Act".

(2) Notwithstanding this section to the contrary, the wildlife resources director and the director's agents, through the county clerks or other legally designated license sales agents, have the power to issue an annual sport combination hunting and fishing license upon payment of a five dollar (\$5.00) fee to residents of Tennessee who are under the age of eighteen (18) and who are disabled.


(3) As used in this subsection (e), "disabled" means the inability to engage in any substantial gainful activity by reason of any medically determinable physical or mental impairment that is certified by a licensed physician. This means that the condition must be both totally and permanently disabling. The director shall accept as evidence for the purposes of this subsection (e) a certificate from a physician licensed to practice medicine in this state certifying that the applicant meets the requirements of this subsection (e) with reference to being disabled.

(4) The commission shall promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with Title 4, Chapter 5, to specifically denote on the license that the person is disabled.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


