### HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 368

A RESOLUTION to honor Paul Coppedge of Clarksville on his remarkable golfing accomplishments.

WHEREAS, legendary American golf champion Arnold Palmer once said, "Success in golf depends less on strength of body than upon strength of mind and character"; and

WHEREAS, exhibiting such strength is Paul Coppedge of Clarksville, who has the distinct honor of having hit three holes-in-one on the same golf hole, on the same golf course, over the last fourteen years; and

WHEREAS, an amazing competitor with an average golf score of 82 and a handicap of 10, Mr. Coppedge hit his first hole-in-one at Number 5 on the Eastland Green Golf Course in Clarksville in 1996, while playing golf left-handed; and

WHEREAS, more remarkably, Mr. Coppedge recorded his second hole-in-one on Number 5 eight years later in 2004, and his third in May of 2010 – both while playing right-handed; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly find it singularly fitting to honor Paul Coppedge for his commitment to excellence in his chosen sport of golf; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we congratulate Paul Coppedge upon his extraordinary golfing accomplishments, commend him for his dedication to the pursuit of perfection, and offer him our best wishes for much continued success on the golf course.
