WHEREAS, excelling in the area of recruitment, Myron Johnson left government service in June of 2004, when he was named Executive Recruiter/Staffing Agent for Adeco Employment Services of Memphis. He later worked as a recruitment specialist for Pinnacle Airlines, Inc. of Memphis; and

WHEREAS, returning to the education profession, Mr. Johnson was employed by Shelby County Schools in February 2009 to serve as a behavioral specialist. Named as the Director of Operations of Future America in March of 2008, Myron Johnson would serve in that capacity until January of 2011; and


