WHEREAS, Nick Merriwether, son of the head coach, scored several three-pointers, Reggie Green, Most Outstanding Player, scored twenty points and collected fourteen rebounds, and Robert Washington scored sixteen points and collected thirteen rebounds, leading the team to a close 58-55 win over their opponents; and

WHEREAS, the valiant effort of every member of the Lester Middle School Lions basketball team resulted in a successful season capped with the 2012 Small Schools Tennessee State Championship title; and


