WHEREAS, ranked fifth in the ESPN Hoopgultz Fab 50, the Riverdale High School Lady Warriors basketball team is one such estimable team. The Lady Warriors recently won the 2011-2012 TSSAA AAA Basketball State Tournament Championship, posting an outstanding record of thirty-four wins and three losses; and

WHEREAS, after advancing to the State Tournament Championship game at the Murphy Center on the campus of Middle Tennessee State University, Riverdale High School captured the AAA State Girls Basketball Championship for its second title in three seasons with a resounding 70-55 triumph over nationally-ranked Science Hill High School; and

WHEREAS, withstanding Science Hill's furious third-quarter comeback effort, the Lady Warriors rallied together in the fourth quarter with a full-court press to capture the state championship trophy; and

WHEREAS, Middle Tennessee State University signee Olivia Jones scored fifteen points, Alexa Middleton posted fourteen points, and Toyree Watkins added twelve to join teammates Shacobia Barbee and Tyisha Petty on the All-Tournament Team; and

WHEREAS, the leadership and passion for the game of head coach John Wild is without peer; Coach Wild's precepts of playing tenacious defense, controlling the ball on offense, and limiting mistakes were perfectly on display during the Lady Warrior's run to the championship; and

WHEREAS, displaying great sportsmanship and outstanding character throughout the season, the members of the Riverdale High School Lady Warriors basketball team conducted themselves in a manner appropriate to the integrity of the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the dedication, determination, work ethic, and talent of this group of young women not only made possible a memorable championship season, but also surely point toward their success in every future endeavor; and
