WHEREAS, the highest rank a Boy Scout can attain is that of Eagle Scout, and Phillip Alexander "Alex" Seeley, after considerable effort and diligent preparation, is joining the prestigious Eagle Court of Honor; and

WHEREAS, as a football player, he has been included on Friday Night Football Tennessee Magazine's Reebok team and is listed as one of the top offensive tackle prospects in the State for the Class of 2012; and

WHEREAS, beginning in the fall of 2012, Alex plans to play football for the University of Tennessee, Chattanooga; and

WHEREAS, he is also an active and devout member of the Dallas Bay Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, Alex's hard work and recent honor are a great source of pride to his parents; and

WHEREAS, his notable record of achievement as a member of Boy Scouts Troop #166 includes numerous Merit Badges and a history of distinguished service; and

WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Mr. Seeley contributed many improvements to the facilities at Soddy-Daisy High School, including painting exterior doors, handrails, and curbs, pressure-washing the sidewalks and entryways, and parking spot striping; and

WHEREAS, Alex's Eagle project greatly contributed to the betterment of his community and reflected the true spirit of Volunteerism; and


WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should pause to recognize Alex Seeley as one of the most outstanding young people in our great State; now, therefore,
