A RESOLUTION to honor and recognize Pastor Elliot R. Shelton, Sr. and Jeaneen Shelton for their meritorious service to Promise Land Church.

WHEREAS, for two years, Pastor Shelton led the congregation of New Hope MBC in Helena, Arkansas before reuniting with Promise Land in April of 2000; and

WHEREAS, his tireless efforts to grow and improve the congregation at Promise Land have resulted in the church moving to a new and bigger location, the addition of new disciples and staff members, and the implementation of a variety of new ministries designed to serve the unique needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, in the twelve years he has served Promise Land, Pastor Shelton has increased the congregation from forty to 800 members, proving just how uplifting his ministry has been for so many people; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Elliot Shelton's success depends greatly on the love, companionship, and support of his wife, Jeaneen, who has graciously undertaken a life of service and Christian stewardship with her husband; and


