WHEREAS, throughout the 2012 legislative session, Ms. Zeitlin has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious legislative intern; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Hannah Zeitlin has performed her many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
