A RESOLUTION recognizing May 14-18, 2012, as "NAIA Women's Golf National Championship Days" in Tennessee.

WHEREAS, four rounds of a seventy-two-hole championship play tournament will take place each day, May 14-18, 2012; and

WHEREAS, one hundred forty-four athletes from NAIA-affiliated conferences/unaffiliated groupings, at-large selections, the host institution, and individual qualifiers will take the course; and

WHEREAS, many states and provinces will be represented at this competition; and

WHEREAS, this sporting event boosts tourism and impacts the economy of Greene County by hosting the participants, coaches, officials, NAIA staff, and spectators; and

WHEREAS, through Champions of Character, the NAIA seeks to create an environment in which student athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators are committed to the true spirit of competition through the five core values: respect, integrity, responsibility, servant leadership, and sportsmanship; and


