WHEREAS, her noteworthy achievement is a tremendous source of pride for her parents, Bill and Angie Owen, her school, and her community; and


WHEREAS, Carlye Owen's dedication to excellence is clearly deserving of the respect, admiration, and commendation of this legislative body; now, therefore,
