WHEREAS, throughout the 2011 legislative session, Mr. Haynes has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious Legislative Intern; and


WHEREAS, Garrett Haynes has performed his many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
