WHEREAS, throughout the 2011 legislative session, Ms. Hicks has surpassed all criteria that define a devoted and conscientious Legislative Intern; and


WHEREAS, Leslie Hicks has performed her many duties with extraordinary insight and rare decorum; now, therefore,
