A RESOLUTION to honor and commend the Lipscomb University Institute for Conflict Management.

WHEREAS, the Institute for Conflict Management has provided extensive service to the Public Sector of Tennessee by training Tennessee legislators, consulting on state educational policy, and facilitating conversations among municipal leaders in Tennessee on various issues; and

WHEREAS, clients of the Institute's students, agents and professors receive the highest level of service resulting in avoidance of costly litigation to individuals and the courts; and


