WHEREAS, because of the exemplary quality of his work, David Kirk was elected Marion County Mayor in August of 2010, in which capacity he served with the utmost probity and character until his untimely passing; and

WHEREAS, David Kirk enjoyed the loving companionship of his wife of forty-one years, Gayle Collins Kirk; and
