WHEREAS, Miss Harrison is also deeply committed to her academic studies, scoring a 30 on the ACT college entrance exam; and

WHEREAS, Olivia Harrison epitomizes all that is good in today's student athlete, as she has achieved a high level of success in sports while demonstrating great character both on and off the field; and

WHEREAS, Miss Harrison's extraordinary honor is a source of great pride for her family, school, and community, and it is appropriate that we pause in our deliberations to applaud this elite athlete for her stellar achievements; now, therefore,


