SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 585

A RESOLUTION to congratulate the founders, sponsors, volunteers, and participants upon the 50th anniversary of the Houston County Irish Celebration.

WHEREAS, it is fitting that this General Assembly should pay tribute to those events that promote local business, entertain and educate our citizens, and celebrate the history and culture of the great State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Houston County Irish Celebration is one such event that is commemorating its fiftieth anniversary this year; and

WHEREAS, created out of fractions of Stewart, Humphrey, and Dickson Counties, Houston County was established on January 21, 1871, and named in honor of the legendary general and former Governor of Tennessee, Sam Houston; and

WHEREAS, although the first settlers of Houston County were of Scottish and Scot/Irish descent, Irish immigrants arrived soon thereafter with the building of the railroad; and

WHEREAS, overcome by the beautiful and lush green vegetation of the area, the Irish laborers called the little valley "Erin" and wisely decided to make it their home; and

WHEREAS, many years later, Dr. O.S. Luton and Mr. Beverly Price were struck with the brilliant idea to celebrate the region's rich Irish heritage and partnered with the Houston County Chamber of Commerce to host the first "Wearing of the Green" on March 16, 1963; and

WHEREAS, expected to draw more than 25,000 attendees, this year's week-long celebration will run from March 9-17, 2012, and feature pageants, a parade, an arts and crafts show, a banquet, delectable cuisine, musical entertainment, and a carnival; and

WHEREAS, the much-anticipated event will begin with a kick-off breakfast where the most honored Lord High Mayor and Emerald Award Winners will be announced, and it will culminate a week later with a day-long celebration of all things Irish; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an appropriate copy of this resolution be prepared for presentation with this final clause omitted from such copy.
