AN ACT to repeal Chapter 771 of the Private Acts of 1949 and Chapter 374 of the Private Acts of 1972, and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the democratic party executive committee in Dekalb County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 771 of the Private Acts of 1949 and Chapter 374 of the Private Acts of 1972, and any other acts amendatory thereto, are hereby repealed in their entireties.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Dekalb County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of Dekalb County and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.


