AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 4, Part 2, relative to an additional tourist accommodation tax upon the occupancy of each hotel room located within the territory of certain metropolitan governments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-4-202(d), is amended by deleting subdivision (2) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following new language:

(2) The authority to charge the amount of the privilege tax imposed on hotel room occupancy by subsection (a) in excess of two dollars (\$2.00) and the terms of the committee members shall expire six (6) years from May 21, 2014.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
