AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, Chapter 1, Part 1, relative to the termination of parental rights.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-1-113, is amended by adding the following new subdivision to subsection (g):

() The parent or guardian has been convicted of trafficking for commercial sex act under § 39-13-309;


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
