AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-21-219, relative to the department of correction.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 41-21-219, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and by adding the following language as a new subsection (b):

(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the commissioner's ability or discretion in enacting policies or undertaking rehabilitative, anti-recidivism, or reentry assistance programs for probationers or parolees.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


