AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 1, relative to K-12 education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, SECTION 49-1-201(d), is amended by deleting subdivision (1) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(1) Upon application by the LEA for one (1) or more of its schools, the commissioner of education may waive any state board rule or statute that inhibits or hinders the LEA's ability to meet its goals or comply with its mission. However, the commissioner may not waive regulatory or statutory requirements related to:

- (A) Federal and state civil rights;
- (B) Federal, state and local health and safety;
- (C) Federal and state public records;
- (D) Immunizations;
- (E) Possession of weapons on school grounds;
- (F) Background checks and fingerprinting of personnel;
- (G) Federal and state special education services;
- (H) Student due process
- (I) Parental rights;
- (J) Federal and state student assessment and accountability;
- (K) Open meetings;
- (L) Educators' due process rights; and
- (M) Reductions in teachers' salaries.
- (N) Employee rights, salaries and benefits; and
- (O) Licensure of employees.


SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
