AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 4, relative to illegal drugs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-438(a)(1), is amended by adding the following as new subdivisions:

() Quinolinyndolecarboxesters, being any compound structurally derived from indole-3carboxylic acid-1H-quinoliny ester structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indole ring by alkyl, haloalkyl, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, 1-(N-methyl-2-piperidinyl) methyl, or 2-(4-morpholinyl) ethyl group, whether or not further substituted in the indole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted in the quinoliny ring to any extent; including, but not limited to PB-22, or F-PB-22;

() (1-Aminocarbonyl)propylindazolecarboxamides, being any compound structurally derived from 3-[(1-aminocarbonyl) 1-propyl] indazole carboxamide structure with substitution at either nitrogen atom of the indazole ring by alkyl, haloalkyl, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, 1-(N-methyl-2-piperidinyl) methyl, or 2-(4-morpholinyl) ethyl group, whether or not further substituted in the indazole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted in the propyl chain to any extent; including, but not limited to AB-Pinaca, or AB-Fubinaca;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-406(d), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

() 25H-NBOMe, being any compound structurally derived from 2-(2,5-dimethoxyphenyl)-N-(2-methoxybenzyl) ethanamine structure with substitution in either phenyl ring to any extent; including, but not limited to 25I-NBOMe, 25-B-NBOMe, or 25C-NBOMe;

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it.
