AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67, relative to taxation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1514, is amended by deleting the first sentence of subsection (k) and substituting instead the following:

Application for registration or renewal of registration by a person or a firm not a resident of this state shall constitute appointment of the secretary of state as the applicant's agent upon whom process may be served in any action or proceeding against the applicant arising out of any transaction or operation connected with or incidental to services performed by the applicant while a registrant within this state. Service of process on the secretary of state shall be made in the manner set forth in § 20-2-215 and § 20-2-216.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
