AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 1; Title 49, Chapter 2 and Title 49, Chapter 5, Part 1, relative to licensure.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(a)(5)(A), is amended by deleting subdivision (ii) in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-5-108(c), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() A supervisor's, principal's or teacher's license shall not be nonrenewed or revoked by the department of education based on student growth data as represented by the Tennessee value-added system (TVAAS), developed pursuant to chapter 1, part 6 of this title, or some other comparable measure of student growth, if no such TVAAS data is available.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of promulgating rules and regulations, this act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.


