AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-11-318, relative to bounty hunters.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-11-318, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

() No bounty hunter shall wear, carry, or display any uniform, badge, shield, card, or other item with any printing, insignia, or emblem that purports to indicate that such bounty hunter is an employee, officer, or agent of any local, state or federal government or any political subdivision of any local, state or federal government.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
