AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 34, relative to conservatorships.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 34-3-106, is amended by deleting subdivision (2) in its entirety and substituting instead:

(2) Present evidence, including testimony or other evidence from a physician, psychologist or senior psychological examiner of the respondent's choosing, and confront, as a cross-examiner, witnesses;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 34-3-107, is amended by redesignating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following new subsection:

(b) If the court grants a protective order placing under seal the respondent's financial information, as provided by § 34-3-106(6), the order shall not deny access to information regarding fees and expenses of the conservatorship.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it.
