AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to duty-free teacher time.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(e)(2), is amended by deleting the language "duty-free planning periods during the established instructional day" and by substituting instead the following:

individual duty-free planning periods during the established instructional day

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-302(e)(2), is further amended by deleting the language "planning time shall be provided each week during which teachers have no other assigned duties or responsibilities, other than planning for instruction" and by substituting instead the following:

individual planning time shall be provided each week during which teachers have no other assigned duties or responsibilities, other than planning for instruction


SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
