AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 71, Chapter 3, Part 1, relative certain assistance payments to parents or caretakers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 71-3-104(h)(2)(B), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (iv):

(iv) The personal responsibility plan shall include requirements, if the need is identified relative to the child, that:

(A) The parent or a suitable adult or guardian shall attend two (2) or more conferences within a year with the child's teacher to review the child's status in school;

(B) Attend at least eight (8) hours of parenting classes; or

(C) The parent shall participate in such support services that the child may need as determined by the department to overcome any school, family, or other barriers that may interfere with the child's and the family's ability to be successful.

SECTION 2. The commissioner of human services is authorized to promulgate rules to effectuate the purposes of this act. All rules shall be promulgated in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.


