## PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 999

SENATE BILL NO. 2252

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 10 and Title 55, Chapter 50, relative to driver points assigned for accidents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-505(a)(1)(C), is amended by adding the following at the end of the subdivision:

The commissioner shall not add points to a driver record involving any accident that was reported on the Tennessee Uniform Traffic Crash Report as a "vehicle special use (09) police", "(10) ambulance", or "(11) fire apparatus" and on which the report indicates the driver presence as "driver operated government vehicle"; provided, that the driver is not charged with vehicular assault under § 39-13-106, vehicular homicide under § 39-13-213, aggravated vehicular homicide under § 39-13-218, reckless driving under § 55-10-205, or driving under the influence of any controlled substance or controlled substance analogue in violation of § 55-10-401.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.


