AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39; Title 53; Title 63 and Title 68, relative to the treatment of intractable pain.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, Chapter 6, Part 11, is amended by deleting the part in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Within one hundred eighty (180) days of July 1, 2015, the board of medical examiners, the board of osteopathic examination, and the board of nursing shall promulgate a rule in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 5, to repeal any rule or regulation promulgated by the board under the authority conferred by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-6-1111.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.


