AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, relative to professions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-121(1), is amended by deleting the language:

(1) Conviction of a felony shown by a certified copy of the record of the court of conviction;

and substituting instead:

(1) Conviction of a felony shown by a certified copy of the record of the court of conviction, if the felony conviction occurred within three (3) years prior to the board's consideration to suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the certificate of registration;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to actions by the board on or after the effective date of this act.
