AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-602, relative to priority schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-602(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (3) and redesignating the subsequent subdivisions accordingly:

(3) By October 1 of the year prior to the public identification of priority schools pursuant to subdivision (b)(1), the commissioner shall notify any school and its respective LEA if the school is among the bottom ten percent (10%) of schools in overall achievement as determined by the performance standards and other criteria set by the state board.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
