AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-438, relative to drugs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-438(a)(1), is amended by deleting the following language:

It is an offense to knowingly produce, manufacture, distribute, possess or possess with intent to produce, manufacture or distribute the active chemical ingredient in the hallucinogenic plant *salvia divinorum* or the following synthetic cannabinoids:

and substituting instead the following:

It is an offense to knowingly produce, manufacture, distribute, possess, or possess with intent to produce, manufacture, or distribute the active chemical ingredient in the hallucinogenic plant *salvia divinorum* or the following synthetic cannabinoids, including any of their isomers, esters, or salts:

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-438(a)(1)(P), is amended by deleting the language "Quinolinyndolecarboxesters" and substituting instead the language "Quinolinyndolecarboxylate".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-438(a)(1), is further amended by adding the following as new, appropriately designated subdivisions:

() Naphthoylindazoles, being any compound structurally derived from 3-(1-naphthoyl) indazole structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indazole ring, whether or not further substituted in the indazole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted in the naphthyl ring to any extent; including, but not limited to THJ-2201;

() Methylindazolecarboxamidobutanoate, being any compound structurally derived from methyl-2-(indazole-3-carboxamido) butanoate structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indazole ring whether or not further substituted in the indazole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted in the butanyl or methyl chain around the ester to any extent; including, but not limited to AMB and fluoro-AMB;

() Naphthalenyndolecarboxylates, being any compound structurally derived from a naphthalen-1-yl 1H-indole-3-carboxylate structure with substitution at the nitrogen atom of the indole ring by alkyl, haloalkyl, alkenyl, cycloalkylmethyl, cycloalkylethyl, 1-(N-methyl-2-piperidiny) methyl, or 2-(4-morpholinyl) ethyl group, whether or not further substituted in the indole ring to any extent, whether or not substituted in the naphthalene ring to any extent; including, but not limited to NM-2201;

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
