AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, relative to certain dementias.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-11-1404(a), is amended by deleting the language "probable diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or Alzheimer's related dementia" in the first sentence and substituting instead the language "probable diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or Alzheimer's-related dementia, including, but not limited to, dementia with lewy bodies and frontotemporal dementia".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
