AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-102, relative to the definition of a governmental entity under the Tennessee Governmental Tort Liability Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 29-20-102(3)(A), is amended by deleting the language "by an act of the general assembly;" and substituting instead the following language:

by an act of the general assembly. "Governmental entity" also means a nonprofit public benefit corporation or charitable entity, including any entity with tax exempt status under the Internal Revenue Code § 501(c)(3), codified in 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3), that is appointed by statute, ordinance, resolution, contract, or other governmental directive to develop, maintain, manage, and provide services and activities at government owned property that is a public park, including facilities located on park property;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
