Re: Zoloft[®] and sertraline PDL Update

Currently, brand name Zoloft[®] is listed as preferred on the TennCare PDL and counts as a generic toward the prescription limits and co-pay. **Effective March 12, 2007**, brand name Zoloft[®] will become non-preferred and the generic formulation of Zoloft[®], sertraline, will move to preferred status. Sertraline will count as a generic toward the prescription limits and will not require a co-pay. The brand name Zoloft[®] will count as a brand medication toward the prescription limits, require a co-pay (for those recipients who have a brand co-pay), and require a prior approval.
